STEP 3 Preliminary Design Options Presented to Public

A Master Plan for the Springtown Open Space (Formerly the Springtown Golf Course)

The City of Livermore has asked the Livermore Area Recreation and Park District (LARPD) to lead the Springtown Open Space Master Plan process.

The Master Plan includes the City-owned portion of the closed golf course, and excludes the Springtown Association's clubhouse, swimming pools and parking lot.

LARPD has hired RRM Design Group to:

- Step 1 - Collect information on the Master Plan site. **COMPLETED**
- Step 2 – Hold public input meetings; this is for public input ONLY. No plans have been designed yet. **COMPLETED**
- **Step 3 – Prepare three conceptual design options and present them to the public for comments and suggestions.**
- Step 4 – Develop and present a final design recommendation to the LARPD Board and City Council.

RRM Design Group is completing three design options and will be ready to present them to the community and receive public input, comments, and suggestions.

You are invited to attend a public input meeting to discuss the design options on **April 27, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. at the Croce Elementary School Multipurpose Room located at 5650 Scenic Avenue, Livermore, CA.**
