SUBJECT:	Robertson Park Sports Fields Synthetic Turf Replacement Project

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: That the Board of Directors approve moving the Robertson Park Sports Fields Turf Replacement Project forward for fiscal year 2021-2022.

BACKGROUND:

On October 6th, 2012, the synthetic sports fields at Robertson Park were opened for use. These fields have been a great boon to the athletes of Livermore for over nine years, but they are showing their age. The turf fibers that were 2 ¼" tall when new, now average 1 ½" tall, due to breakage from heavy use. In addition to this, in April of 2021, GMAX testing was conducted on both synthetic fields. GMAX testing measures the shock attenuation performance of the field. In other words, GMAX measures how well the turf field absorbs impact. Both fields were tested at ten specific locations within the play area. Both fields failed to meet ASTM standard at multiple locations. In response to this, LARPD staff contracted with T. D. Sports Group to perform extensive turf maintenance to reduce the compaction of the turf in-fill, thereby making it less dense and more shock absorbent. The fields were retested and subsequently passed the standard for GMAX. This, however, was a stop gap measure. At nine years old the artificial turf has surpassed its useful life, the industry standard being 8-10 years. It is time to replace the turf layer of both fields.

NEXT STEPS:

In 2012, LARPD staff opted to purchase the turf directly from the manufacturer (Astroturf) through a CMAS (California Multiple Award Schedules) agreement. The products and services contracted through CMAS have been assessed to be fair, reasonable, and competitive by the State of California. There are several benefits to contracting through CMAS. The two most significant being up-front pricing and the ability to avoid the long, formal bid process. It is the intention of staff to use a CMAS approved contractor for the replacement turf this time as well. Two CMAS approved contractors have

been approached by LARPD staff and we have received two bids which are included with this report as attachments. A third proposal is in the works.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work for this project includes:

- The removal and disposal of the existing turf layer and in-fill. (70% crumb rubber and 30% sand)
- The installation of the new turf layer and in-fill.
- The installation of a shock absorbing pad layer, under the new turf layer.

This pad layer is a change from the original field construction. The 2012 fields do not have a layer of padding under the turf layer. The primary benefit of the pad layer is safety. The pad does not compact over time, so with regular maintenance, fields with a pad layer under the turf will likely never exceed the GMAX standard for impacts/falls. There are, of course, increased costs. Adding a pad will add between \$125,000 and \$175,000 to the cost of one field. On the positive side, because virtually all pads on the market have a 25-year warranty, the pads can be used for up to three turf replacements, reducing total turf replacement costs in the future.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Attachment A is a proposal from Shaw Sports Turf. Three options of turf and two options for pad offer a range from \$1,378,698 to \$1,542,464 for the replacement of both fields, including the installation of the pad layer. Attachment C from Sprinturf is comparable to the highest price turf from Shaw. When broken down per square foot, the pricing is \$6.41/square ft. vs. \$6.82/square ft.

- Quote based upon use of Shaw Sports Turf standard adhesive; other adhesives at additional cost

The term Synthetic Turf, as used herein, shall include only the synthetic turf fibers and backings supplied by Shaw Sports Turf®.

Synthetic Turf is a consumable product and is subject to normal wear and tear, which is not a manufacturing defect and is not covered by this warranty. In addition to the factors mentioned above, wear and tear depends on, without limitation, the construction of the Synthetic Turf, the intensity of use of the Synthetic Turf and climate. Shaw Sports Turf warrants that the Synthetic Turf Fiber will be considered to have maintained UV stability if the weight of the Fiber shall not have decreased by more than ten percent (10%) per year according to ASTM standards, nor exceed fifty percent (50%) during the warranty period as a result of normal and ordinary wear and tear with properly maintained infill levels as required. The Fiber shall be stable to excessive fading and will fade in a uniform manner with no significant color variation except as affected by changes resulting from pile distortion, normal matting, and high wear areas.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANYTHING TO THE CONTRARY CONTAINED IN THIS LIMITED WARRANTY, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY SHALL NOT COVER ANY DEFECTS, FAILURE IN OR DAMAGE TO THE SYNTHETIC TURF THAT IS:
