Please consider this input for an updated policy: if the vehicle is muscle powered, it is welcome on the trails. If the motor is engaged, the vehicle should be on the street. Of course exceptions must be made for disabled users of motorized vehicles. Today, I was passed on the trail by a young person riding a gas powered motorcycle. While this is clearly against current rules, I could see this person's may be thinking "how is this different than some of those electric bikes do." It seems like there are some gray areas that need to be made clear regarding what is permitted and what isn't. Thanks for taking the time to read this. I hope you will consider this issue.</p>
