VOLUNTEER COACHES

Volunteer coaches receive guidance, resources, training, and ongoing support from LARPD staff. No coaching experience needed. 20% registration refund after the soccer season concludes. All volunteer coaches are required to undergo a background check, fingerprinting, mandatory reporting training, concussion protocol compliance, as well as complete 20-minute introductory grassroots coaching online course by US Soccer.



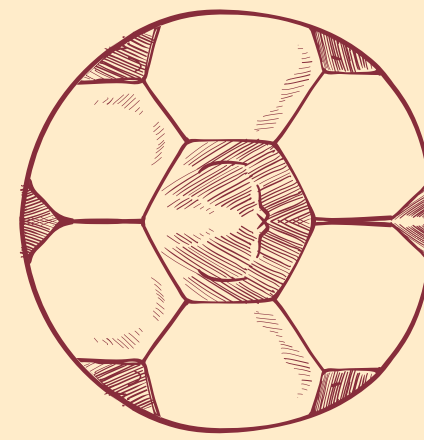
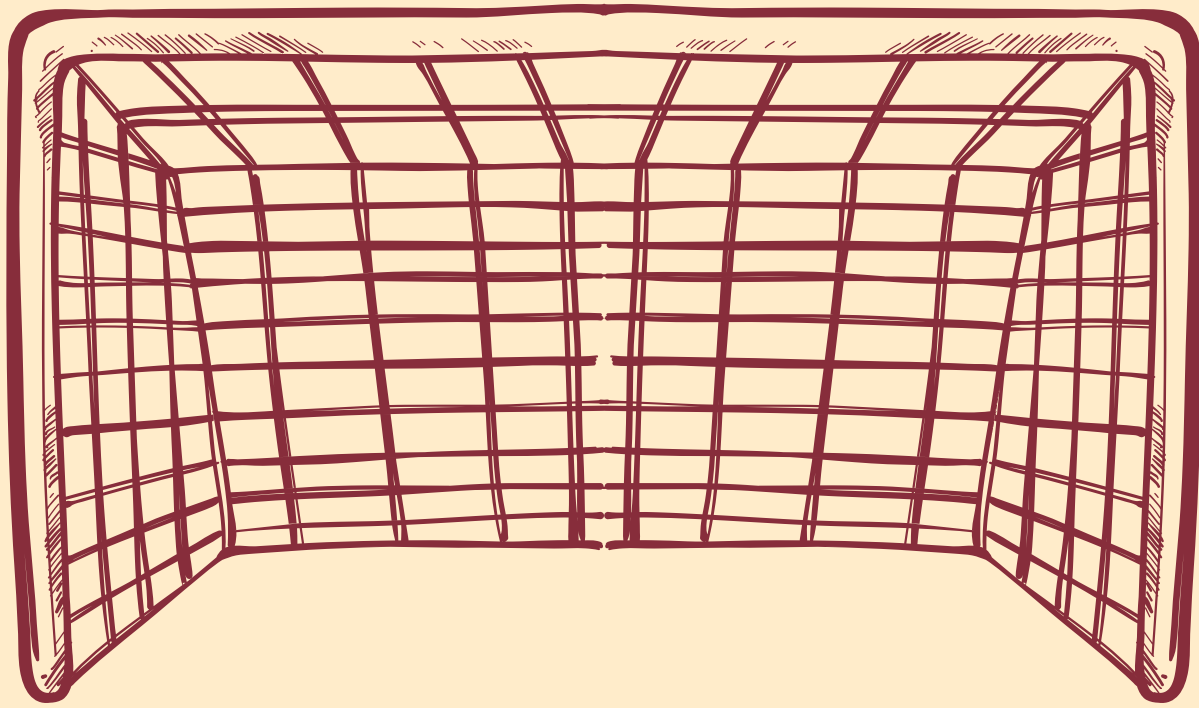

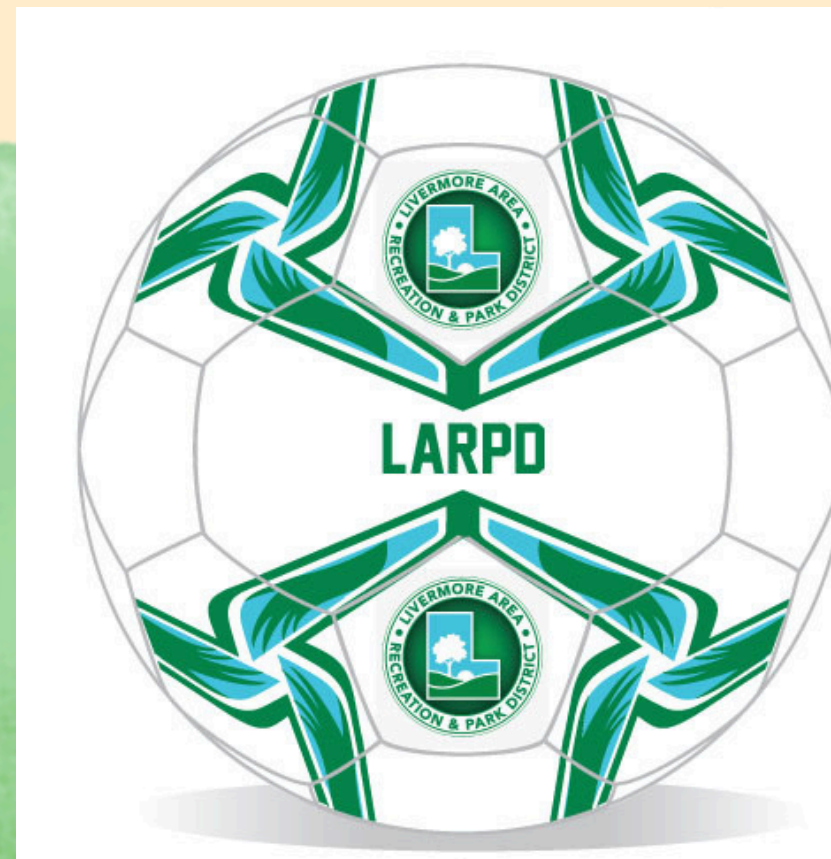
