### **Livermore Area Recreation and Park District Closures in Response to COVID-19**

The health and safety of our community is our highest priority. Based on the Governor's declaration and new guidance from the California Department of Public Health (<https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CID/DCDC/Pages/Immunization/ncov2019.aspx>) and Alameda County Public Health Department (<http://www.acphd.org/2019-ncov.aspx>), Livermore Area and Recreation Park District has decided to cancel ALL recreation programs, events, classes, and rentals beginning **Friday, March 13, 2020 through the end of the month**. The Robert Livermore Community Center, Recreation Building, and Robert Livermore Aquatics Center will be closed to the public during this time. The District will provide refunds to customers for programs and services impacted by this cancellation. Extended Student Services, PAL middle school program and LARPD preschool programs will remain open in coordination with the Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District.

The Open Heart Kitchen lunch program will be offering **to-go** lunches only, and distributing pre-ordered to-go lunch bags from an alternate entrance of the Robert Livermore Community Center, 4444 East Avenue in Livermore.

We continue to take additional precautions in the District offices including heightened custodial protocols and the addition of public hand sanitizing stations throughout our facilities.
